The **Karuk Tribe** has been stewarding their aboriginal territory since time immemorial. Known as the “fix-it” people, their cultural practices are inextricably linked to their ecological stewardship of land, River and more-than-human beings. **Tishánik** is a tribally owned site that the Tribe is currently revitalizing.
