Eligibility/Benefits


Applicants must:

- Be a US Citizen or a Lawful Permanent Resident
- Be 18 years of age
- Have a Master's or Doctoral degree in engineering by the start of the appointment—with an overall GPA of at least 3.0

During the appointment, participants may receive:

- Stipend starting at \$750/week. Stipends will be determined based on academic standing, discipline, experience, and research facility location
- Health insurance supplement
- A relocation allowance, not to exceed \$1,000
